Grammar Hawks will once again enter teams in the Bunbury Hockey Association in 2025. The Bunbury and Districts Junior Hockey Association will again adopt Year Group based grades:

SECONDARY

Grades: J7/8

J9-12

Training: Secondary Teams train on Tuesdays after School

3:45 – 4:45 – when training at Palmer Oval

4:00 – 5:00 – when training at the Bunbury Hockey Stadium

Teams alternate between Palmer and Stadium trainings. For training sessions Hockey Stadium, a bus will depart school at 3.40 and students will need to be collected at the Stadium at 5pm.

REGISTRATION

If your child played in 2024 then you should just be able to renew the registration by clicking on the renew button. Payment will need to be made at the time of registration

There are two components to the fee:

- 1. Hockey Australia fee: a one-off fee of \$57 for all junior players age between 9-17 and \$22 for those under 9 years. You only pay this fee once even if you play for more than one club (ie juniors and seniors).
- 2. Grammar Hawks fee: this includes BDHA fees, turf hire, balls, umpire fee, training equipment, training bus, playing shirt loan, wind up and more!

These will be added together to form the total cost payable by credit card.
