

Ignite Award - Year 7 Students

Students at Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School have an opportunity to participate in the *Ignite Award*. The *Ignite Award* is run by Awards WA and has been designed for younger students to complete as an introduction to the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme. I will also be speaking to the students about the Ignite Award in the next week. Before committing to the program, it is highly recommended that students and parents overview the <u>information</u> carefully.

We recommend students register for the Level 3 and 4 book. The registration fee for the program is \$110 which covers the students for two stages eg- Level 3 and Level 4. Students may register and pay online by clicking the following link <u>Participant Registration Form</u>. After registration is confirmed and paid, students will receive a record book which will be sent to the School. This will allow them to log their activities.

During the course of their involvement with the Ignite Award, students may check in with myself at a mutually convenient time for support or further queries. Once they have completed their record book they need to have it signed off by me to confirm that they have satisfied the requirements of the award and I will organise for the student to receive their certificate of completion and badge. It is expected that students should be able to complete the award/s (either Level 3/Level 4 or both), before their 14th birthday.
